Are you a high school student interested in art and museums? Apply to be a member of the High Museum of Art's Teen Team, a group of 15 **committed, creative, and ambitious** high school students who share a common interest in art and community engagement. The Teen Team organizes teen events and assists with summer camp workshops as well as various projects throughout the year. The Teen Team is looking for **rising juniors and seniors** interested in working with Museum staff, artists, and other creative young people.

The Teen Team meets Tuesday–Friday for eight weeks over the summer, June 10–August 1, 10 a.m.–3 p.m., and approximately once per month during the school year. Each member is paid \$7.25 hourly during the summer session. The meetings and events during the school year are meant to both engage the Teen Team with the High's collections and special exhibitions and broaden their knowledge of art history and museum studies. Members will also advise and coordinate teen events at monthly meetings; participation may count toward volunteer credits.

Applicants must be high school students enrolled for the 2014–2015 school year. E-mail hmateenprograms@woodruffcenter.org for more information.
